- 4. How is "obedience to the unenforceable" similar to "the Golden Rule"? How are they different? Or are they?
- 5. Jonathan Haidt and Craig Joseph describe innate propensities of mind and emotion that become associated to culturally varied practices as "virtues" or "vices." Does this ring true to you? Speaking from the standpoint of evolution, what value might the innate propensities for care, hierarchy, fairness, loyalty, and purity have?
- 6. Frans de Waal studies the evolution of morality through animal behavior. How might the innate ethical intuitions be seen as a pattern of evolutionary emergence?
- 7. What are examples of ethics that seem to be a cultural association of these innate intuitions? Does this mean they can change? Have you seen shifts or changes in your own intuitions over the years?
